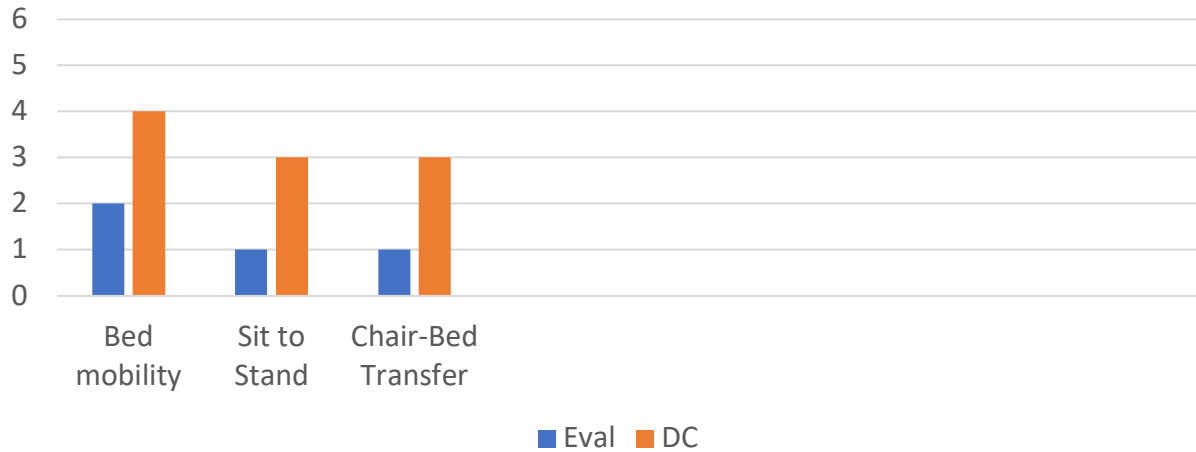
Mr. Ashbrook was a 74-year-old veteran who admitted to Stonegate Nursing and Rehab after experiencing increased weakness and fatigue resulting in a hospitalization. He was found to have cellulitis requiring antibiotics.

Upon evaluation by physical therapy, he required maximum assistance with bed mobility and total assistance with transfers. His occupational therapy evaluation indicated that he required minimal assistance with grooming, moderate assistance with upper body dressing, and maximum assistance with lower body dressing, toileting, and bathing.

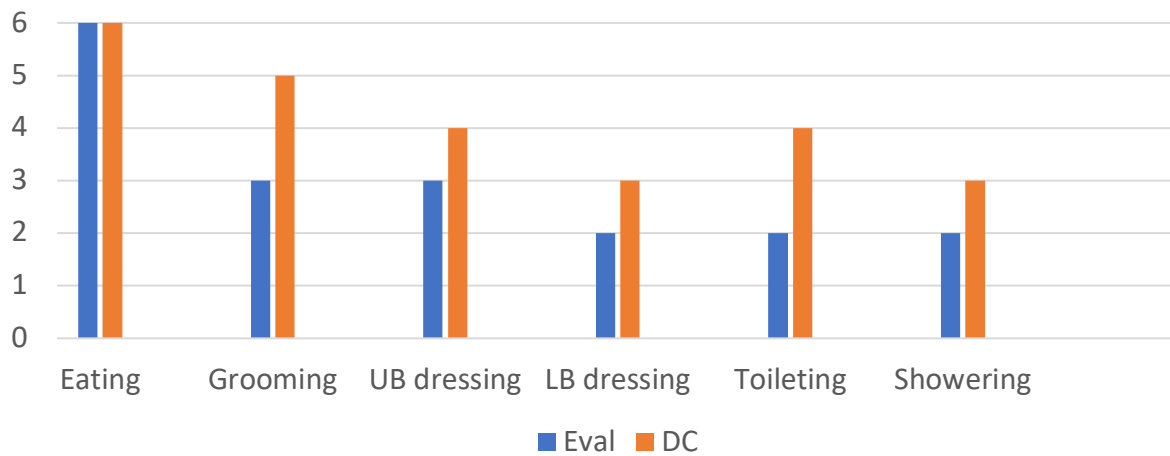
Mr. Ashbrook was very motivated to participate in therapy services. His wife of many years supported him throughout the process. At discharge, he required minimal assistance with bed mobility and transfers. He was even able to walk a few steps. He improved to requiring minimal assistance with upper body dressing and moderate assistance with lower body dressing and toileting. He was able to improve in all areas of self-care and mobility and return home with his wife.

### MDS Section GG Functional Scores

#### 06 - Independent

Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper

#### 05 - Setup or clean-up assistance

Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

#### 04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

#### 03 - Partial/moderate assistance

Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

#### 02 - Substantial/maximal assistance

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

#### 01 - Dependent

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
